

Hyundai Solar Modules Qualify for “BUY AMERICAN”

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) 2009

- ARRA Stimulus Package includes a “BUY AMERICAN” clause, which is in accordance with the U.S. Trade Agreement Act (FAR 52.225-5)
- Under the Trade Agreement Act, the Government may acquire “U.S.-made or designated country end products.”

Trade Agreement Act (1979) FAR [52.225-5]

- U.S.-made end product An article that is mined, produced, or manufactured in the United States or that is substantially transformed in the United States into a new and different article of commerce with a name, character, or use distinct from that of the article or articles from which it was transformed. (FAR25.003)
- World Trade Organization – Government Procurement Agreement country end products

Each of the following countries is a WTO GPA country: Aruba, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, **Korea(Republic of)**, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Singapore, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan and United Kingdom.

Hyundai solar modules are manufactured in the Republic of Korea, and qualify as “WTO-Government procurement Trade Agreement country end products” under the “Trade Agreement Act” clause of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

All Hyundai solar modules qualify under the “BUY AMERICAN” clause of the ARRA.
